POSSIBLE MANIFESTATIONS OF SATANIC STRONGHOLDS

FRUIT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

(Gal. 5:22-23)

FIERY DARTS OF SATAN Eph. 6:16

(attacks, condemnation, deceitful or seducing spirits, schemes, sifting, snares, spiritual fortresses or strongholds, temptation, etc.) FORMATION OF AN INNER/SPIRITUAL STRONGHOLD/ FORTRESS

(II Corinthians 10:3-5)

POSSIBLE MANIFESTATIONS OF A SATANIC STRONGHOLD

[Other explanations are also possible!]

The "fruit of the Holy Spirit" can be borne in our lives ONLY by the Holy Spirit of God working through us in His power and victory. That is, Christians cannot possibly achieve this "fruit" on their own; rather, Christians are merely agents through whom the Holy Spirit can achieve the purposes of God. But, when Christians deliberately suppress the Holy Spirit, although still saved, they can literally give up ground to Satan that rightfully belongs to Jesus Christ. Then, over a period of time, they can eventually come under attack from the powers of darkness.

1. Love	unforgiveness, jealousy resentment, bitterness	hatred	emotional death of a relationship, murder
2. Joy	despair, discouragement	hopelessness	clinical depression, suicide
3. Peace	anxiety, confusion, worry, dismay, fretfulness	fear	emotional breakdown, anxiety disorder
4. Patience Long-suffering	impatience, temper	wrath	fits of rage/violence
5. Kindness	harshness, cruelty	extremely argumentative	self-centeredness, insanity
6. Goodness	evil imaginations (usually sexual)	lust	immorality, perversion
7. Faithfulness	doubt, unbelief	agnosticism	blasphemy of God
8. Gentleness Meekness (Strength under co	self-exaltation, pride, ego ontrol)	rebellion (unteachable)	domination/abuse
9. Self-control (Assuming that se controlled by God	5	instability	gossip, slander, gluttony, substance misuse, addictions, witchcraft

As Satan sends his "fiery darts" our way, seeking to develop some "strongholds" in our lives, and then hoping to see those "strongholds" manifest themselves outwardly, it is very important that we discern the difference between Holy Spirit conviction and Satanic accusation.

I. The Holy Spirit always CONVICTS **LEGITIMATELY**

II. The Holy Spirit always CONVICTS **SPECIFICALLY**

III. The Holy Spirit always CONVICTS **REDEMPTIVELY**
