If you have read these newsletter articles for any length of time, no doubt, you have seen "Stay Tuned!" at the end of each one. These two words take on several meanings. Meanings that are important to me as a Christian man and as a Worship Leader. They can take on a whole new meaning for you as well.

It is of the utmost importance to a musician to ensure that his instrument is in tune. The instrument will not perform as intended if out of tune. A vehicle must be "tuned up" in order for it to run smoothly. The body of an athlete must be "tuned up" to perform at his/her optimum level.
