Names of God: Jehovah Shammah

I am running the risk of sounding redundant, but a good reminder is just that ... a good reminder. We previously learned that the Hebrew word Jehovah can be translated as "Lord." This week we will take a look at another Old Testament name of God, Jehovah Shammah (shawm'-maw). In the Old Testament, Jehovah Shammah occurs only once in Ezekiel 48:35.

If you have been following this series on "The Names of God" you, no doubt, know by now how important a name really is. A name was especially important in biblical times as it revealed the characteristics or attributes of a person. Of course, God was FULLY aware of this and He used different names to reveal Himself to everyone who would hear from those days forward. God uses the familiar things of life to inform, teach, and reveal things to us, knowing the limitations of our hard heads and finite little minds.

Shammah is derived from the Hebrew word sham (shawm), which can be translated as "there." Jehovah Shammah – "The Lord Is There." It is also a symbolic name for the earthly Jerusalem. The name indicates that God has not abandoned Jerusalem but that one day there will be a restoration of Jerusalem to the full glory that God intended for it.
