Names of God El Shaddai

TLast week I wrote about the significance of names especially in Biblical times. We saw where names actually described the attributes and characteristics of a person. In the next few weeks we will discover several names of God and how His various names depict His attributes. At the end of each week's column I will list a few Scripture references so that you can study the circumstances of why God uses a particular name to reference Him at a particular time. This week's name is, "El Shaddai."

Use in the Bible: In the Old Testament El Shaddai occurs 7 times. El Shaddai is first used in Gen 17:1.

"El" is a name that is translated as "God" and can be used in conjunction with other words to designate various aspects of God's character. That is a given, however, many Christians differ on the exact meaning of Shaddai. The most common translation is "Mighty." El Shaddai ... "God Almighty." Another word much like Shaddai, and from which many believe it derived, is "shad" meaning "breast" in Hebrew. This refers to God completely nourishing, satisfying, and supplying His people with all their needs as a mother would her child. When connected with the word for God, El, this denotes a God who freely gives nourishment and blessing, He is our sustainer. Others believe that the name is derived from the word, Šadu, meaning "mountain." This translation refers to God's strength and power as He appeared to Moses on top of Mt. Sinai.

While all three interpretations describe traits of God, I tend to lean toward El Shaddai – God Almighty! As we move through this series we will discuss other names of God that relate to the other translations listed above.

Further references of the name El Shaddai in the Old Testament: Gen 17:1; Gen 28:3; Gen 35:11; Gen 43:14; Gen 48:3.
