

Names of God: Jehovah-Rohi/Raah

This column continues looking at the various names of God so we can glean a better understanding of who God is by understanding His character and attributes. This week we look at the name, Jehovah Raah (raw-aw'). There is another variation on this name, Jehovah Rohi (ro'eh). We previously learned that Jehovah means Lord or God. Let's now take a look at the meaning of the name, Rohi/Raah.

I do not pretend to be a Hebrew scholar, just a biblical scholar. However, In the Hebrew language, Rohi (Rô'eh) means "shepherd." We probably are already aware that a shepherd is one who feeds, leads to and protects his flock. God is sufficient to lead us, feed us (physically and spiritually), and protect us. Jehovah Rohi, The Lord My Shepherd - Lord shepherds me.

The variation Raah derived directly from Rohi. I have a little space left in this column, so let's extend this translation out one more step. An extended translation of this word, 'rea,' is "friend" or "companion." When the two words, Rohi and rae, are combined we get the name, Raah. Jehovah Raah - it can now be translated as "The Lord my Friend." This indicates the intimacy God desires between Himself and us. How about, The Lord Is My Shepherd! The Lord Is My Friend!

Further references of the name Jehovah-Raah in the Old Testament: Genesis 48:15; Genesis 49:24; Psalms 23:1; Psalms 80:1
